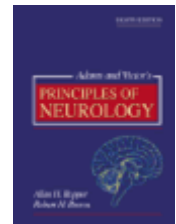
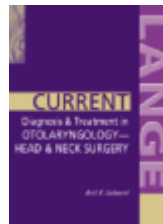
Welcome

New DVDs

The Library has purchased some new General Surgery DVDs. These cover surgical techniques in Colorectal, Upper GI, Thyroid and Breast Surgery. To view the titles, go to the Library catalogue on the [Library page](#) of the College website, type "dvd" into the search box to see a list and then request your selections.

Plastic Surgery Resources

The online Library now has Grabb and Smith's Plastic Surgery available as a full-text resource. The Library brochures had previously advertised Green's Operative Hand Surgery and Mathes Plastic Surgery as forthcoming titles, however the publisher (Elsevier) has since withdrawn the possibility of a site licence. These titles are only available as an individual subscription.

Foot and Ankle International

The Library is pleased to announce that this popular journal is now available as a full-text resource in the Online Library. On most PCs, the publisher requires a click through security software. For IE please choose "yes" to accept security certificate, if

necessary. For Firefox please choose "accept certificate permanently", if necessary.

Elsevier - Science Direct

Elsevier and Science Direct articles are now charged per full text download (instead of a flat rate subscription). Please keep this in mind and save or print out any articles you may need to refer to regularly. Library policy at present is not to take on any new Elsevier or Science Direct subscriptions. However, when current subscriptions move from another publisher to Elsevier, they will usually be maintained.

Books by Fellows

It is a goal of the Library to hold all titles written by our Fellows, so please let us know when you publish a book or new edition that you have written or contributed to. You can either donate a copy or the Library will buy one. Any donations are acknowledged by a special book plate inside the cover.

When Fellows are clearing out their personal libraries, they sometimes offer these to the Library. Due to limited space, the Library can only accept Australasian material, rare books or those written or contributed to by Fellows of the College. Please contact the Library Manager if you would like to donate any books within those categories.

Library Catalogue

The Library Catalogue is now available online. You may request books and videos/DVDs to be posted out to you as required (except Not for Loan items). The online books have also been catalogued and will come up in relevant searches – simply click the link to access the full text of these.

Video Amnesty

The College video collection is, where possible, being converted to DVD and added to the Library Catalogue. DVD is a much better format for posting, and for viewing on laptops etc. Once they have been added to the catalogue, the process of finding and ordering the DVDs will be much simpler.

To facilitate this process, we would greatly appreciate the return of ALL videos that anyone may have. Please check your shelves for any College videos and return them to the library as soon as possible. No matter how long you have had them – we need them back.

The Library would welcome the return of any library books you might find too.

Staff Changes

Literature Searches

User guides and support are available for Fellows and Trainees who wish to do literature searches using Medline, a resource offered through the online library. The reason for this is that due to budgetary constraints, the Librarian position is being replaced on a part time basis. Journal articles will continue to be available on request or via the online library.
