### BJS and other new journals

Fellows and Trainees are now able to access the full-text of British Journal of Surgery, Cancer and Head and Neck via the College's Online Library. These titles are available as part of the College's contract with Wiley-Blackwell who publish these journals, along with the ANZ Journal of Surgery.

### Elsevier/Science Direct journals

For the past three years the College has been part of a health libraries consortium which has included a large bundle of Science Direct titles as part of the membership deal. Under new terms of offer from the publisher, the College now subscribes to individual titles rather than the bundle. The key specialty and most highly used titles have been retained. These are -
