

HONORARY FELLOWSHIP

Council was first given the power to elect Honorary Fellows under the By-Laws adopted at the first meeting of the Founders of the College at Dunedin on 5 February 1927.

Article 20 of the College's Articles of Association says that "The Council may admit distinguished surgeons, scientists or other persons as Honorary Fellows of the College provided that three quarters of Councillors present and voting vote in favour of such admission and provided that no surgeon practising in Australasia shall be eligible for Honorary Fellowship." The purpose of the award is to recognise significant work of eminent individuals in any field of endeavour.

Nomination to Honorary Fellowship shall be made in writing and shall contain biographical details of the nominee and information on appointments, membership of learned societies (and office held), and a list of publications.
