


More than 23.3M total My Health Records







Benefits of using My Health Record reported by private specialists

- Saving time requesting and gathering patient medical information
- Being able to view information that was previously unknown and otherwise would not have been accessible
- Not needing to order a pathology test by being able to see previous test results
- Not needing to order a diagnostic imaging test by being able to see previous test results
- Saving time collating and communicating information to other providers

MHR avoids unnecessary investigations, shorter stays in hospital, greater continuity of care, and we're less likely to make mistakes. I wish more was uploaded.







- Allows access and viewing of all documents and overviews
- Easily upload a copy of your specialist letter into a patient's My Health Record, without interrupting your normal workflow
- Easily upload a copy of the prescriptions you write to a patient's My Health Record
- Allows viewing by authorised practice staff (non-clinical)
- Practice staff can upload specialist authored letter (once approved)



Evolution of Prescriptions






What are electronic prescriptions?



- Electronic prescriptions are an alternative option to paper prescriptions.
- Previously, only a paper prescription signed by a prescriber has been the legal form by which medicines can be supplied.
- Paper and electronic prescriptions meet both the relevant Commonwealth, state and territory legislation.
- Electronic prescriptions are not mandatory.
- Patients and prescribers are able to choose between a paper and an electronic prescription.







Telehealth consultations - benefits

Healthcare providers can benefit from telehealth consults through:

- Reduced travel, expense and time away from home
- Higher patient reach
- Reduced patient 'no-shows'
- 'Just in time' assistance with difficult cases and emergencies
- Professional development for clinicians, e.g. informal knowledge transfer
- Reduced professional isolation through collaboration and networking.



Telehealth Statistics

Between 13 March 2020 and 31 July 2022, 118.2 million telehealth services have been delivered to 18 million patients, and more than 95,000 practitioners have now used telehealth services

Telehealth consultations - considerations

When starting an appointment

- Check for confidential information, such as healthcare data that may be visible
- Confirm each person's identity and check for unauthorised participants on the call
- Request a phone number to call if the connection drops

Maintain a secure system

- Use reputable and secure Online Conferencing Technologies
- Keep your operating system and software up to date
- Where possible, use different computers for work and general browsing






