A Tasmanian Labor Government will implement its Health Action Plan from Day One to address rampant waitlists and wait times across the state.

Labor's Hospital Outpatient and Surgery Plan will support improved public access to surgical procedures through the recruitment of an additional 65 medical and surgical specialists.
