ROLE OVERVIEW

The Surgical Sciences and Clinical Examinations (SSE&CE) Committee Chair's (Chair) role is to facilitate the on-going development and delivery of the:

- Generic Surgical Sciences Examination (GSSE);
- Clinical Examination (CE);
- Cardiothoracic Surgical Sciences and Principles (CSSP);
- Surgical Sciences Examination in Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery;
- Plastic and Reconstructive Surgical Sciences and Principles Examination
- Surgical Sciences Examination in Urology
- Surgical Sciences Examination in Vascular Surgery

The Chair oversees the above examinations, providing a link between Fellows, other subject matter experts (SME) responsible for creating and standard setting the above examinations, the exminations staff, the Prevocational and Skills Education Committee and the Board of Surgical Education and Training.
