"Type of Anaesthetic" field in the Case Details: Expanded Dataset is now a multi pick field


Additional search fields added to Journal/Supervisor Journal replacing Keywords search

This enhancement increases the speed of the search function.


Note: Search filters applied will display in the top left of the Journal/Supervisor Journal screens. The "Clear" button should be used to remove all previous search filters.
