



## Change to supervision levels for Fellow logbooks

In response to member feedback and in consultation with the MALT Committee, three new supervision levels have been added to the MALT Fellow Logbooks.

These new Supervision Levels have been included to provide a range of options that capture the different roles undertaken by Fellows in theatre.

New / Existing	Supervision Level	Description
Existing	Primary Surgeon (P)	Primary Surgeon
New	Performed with peer (PP)	Surgeon working with peer or with peer support in a complex or new procedure or in a combined procedure with another specialty.
Existing	Assisting (scrubbed) (AS)	Assisting
Existing	Observing (not scrubbed) (ONS)	Procedure observed, not scrubbed.
New	Supervising (scrubbed) (SS)	Supervising - in theatre at the table actively assisting and training.
New	Supervising (in theatre, not scrubbed) (SNS)	Supervising – not scrubbed but in the operating theatre; actively watching the procedure and able to provide advice or scrub in if required.
Existing	Available (A)	Not in the theatre but available by telephone for advice and able to attend if required.
