Eligibility summary

Early career RACS Fellows (Fellowship within the past ten years)

Interest area

International travel – clinical activity or research

The Morgan Travel Fellowship, established through the generosity of Mr Brian Morgan, a retired General Fellow, supports RACS Fellows to travel overseas for the purpose of gaining clinical experience or conducting research.

Conditions

This guideline outlines information specific to the respective grant's purpose, duration, conditions and recipient eligibility. For all the conditions for this scholarship it is essential that you also read the Learning and Development Policy.

Applicant eligibility

Applications are open to RACS Fellows who have gained their Fellowship within the past ten years.

Eligible activity

The fellowship is to fund travel, accommodation and living expenses to support the recipient in gaining clinical experience or conducting research overseas.

Selection process

The selection panel is comprised of the Chair and two members of the ANZ Scholarship and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

Financial arrangements

The grant funding will be paid to the recipient following receipt of a valid tax invoice as requested by the Scholarships and Grants department. Payment will be made in one instalment before 1 March in the grant activity year.
