The Morgan Travel Fellowship, established through the generosity of Mr Brian Morgan, a retired General Fellow, supports RACS Fellows to travel overseas for the purpose of gaining clinical experience or conducting research.

Conditions

Applicant eligibility

Applications are open to RACS Fellows who have gained their Fellowship within the past ten years.

Eligible activity

The grant is to fund travel, accommodation and living expenses to support the recipient in gaining clinical experience or conducting research overseas.

Selection panel

The selection panel is comprised of the Chair and two members of the ANZ Scholarship and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

Funding source

This Fellowship is funded from income derived from the Morgan Travelling Fellowship corpus under the Foundation for Surgery
