Roy and Marjory Edwards Research Scholarship

The Roy and Marjory Edwards Research Scholarship supports medical research undertaken as part of a higher degree, conducted at a South Australian university. The Edwards owned a large pastoral company in South Australia. The scholarship was established from a donation by the late Mrs Edwards after her husband Roy died.

Conditions

Applicant eligibility

Applications are open to RACS Fellows, Specialist International Medical Graduates (SIMGs), SET Trainees who are enrolled (or intend to enrol) in a higher degree such as a Masters or PhD at a South Australian University.

Eligible activity

A medical research project undertaken as part of a higher degree at a South Australian university.

Selection

Selection is assessed via written application with shortlisted applicants invited to interview. The selection panel is comprised of the Chair (or their nominee) and two members of ANZ Scholarship and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

Recipient obligations

Recipients are required to present their research at the annual meeting of the Surgical Research Society of Australasia, at least once, during the scholarship period or within 12 months following the scholarship period.

Financial arrangements

The scholarship will be paid to the administering institution upon receipt of a valid tax invoice as requested by the Scholarships and Grants department. Payment will be made in one instalment prior to 1 March in the scholarship year.

This scholarship is made up of a stipend component and a departmental component.
