## Research Scholarships Guideline

Governing Policy: Research Scholarship Policy

## Foundation for Surgery Research Scholarship

The Foundation for Surgery Research Scholarship supports surgeons and SET Trainees who wish to take time away from clinical positions to undertake a research project within a higher degree under the supervision of an experienced investigator.

### Conditions

#### Applicant eligibility

Applications are open to RACS Fellows, special international medical graduates (SIMGs) and SET Trainees enrolled (or intending to enrol) in a higher degree such as a Masters or PhD.

#### Eligible activity

A research project undertaken as part of a higher degree, at an approved research institute under the supervision of an experienced investigator.

#### Selection

Selection is via assessment of the written application with shortlisted applicants invited to interview.

The selection panel is comprised of the Chair (or their nominee) and two members of the ANZ Scholarship and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

#### Recipient obligations

Recipients are required to present their research at the annual meeting of the Surgical Research Society of Australasia (or an agreed equivalent) at least once during, or in the 12 months following the scholarship period.

#### Financial arrangements

The scholarship will be paid to the administering institution upon receipt of a valid tax invoice as requested by the Scholarships and Grants department. Payment will be made in one instalment prior to 1 March in the scholarship year.

The scholarship is made up of a stipend component and a department component.
