Governing Policy: Learning and Development Grants

Morgan Travel Fellowship

The Morgan Travel Fellowship supports RACS Fellows to travel overseas and gain clinical experience or conduct research. The Fellowship was established following a series of donations from colorectal surgeon, Mr Brian Morgan AM.

Conditions

Applicant eligibility

To be eligible for this Fellowship, you need to be a RACS Fellow.

Eligible activity

The grant may be used to fund overseas travel, accommodation and living expenses.

Selection

Selection is based upon:

- your activity proposal including: how your activity will benefit your professional development; and contribute to improving Australian and/or Aotearoa New Zealand surgical standards and knowledge base
- the expected outcomes of your activity
- proposed costs
- references.

The selection panel is comprised of members of the Australia and New Zealand Scholarship and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

Acknowledgment

The grant is to be acknowledged by the recipient in all related communication as the Morgan Travel Fellowship, (supported by the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons), and is to be accompanied by the Foundation for Surgery logo on all related presentations.
