Governing Policy: Learning and Development Grants

Murray and Unity Pheils Travel Grant

The Murray and Unity Pheils Travel Grant supports Fellows and Trainees to obtain further training and experience in the field of colorectal surgery. The grant enables a RACS Fellow or Trainee to undertake colorectal surgery training overseas, or an overseas-based surgeon to undertake training in Australia or Aotearoa New Zealand.

Conditions

Applicant eligibility

Applications are open to RACS Fellows and SET Trainees.

Eligible activity

The grant funds international travel to obtain further training and experience at a specialist colorectal unit.

Selection

Selection is based upon:

- your activity proposal including: how your activity will benefit your professional development; and contribute to improving Australian and/or Aotearoa New Zealand surgical standards and knowledge base
- the expected outcomes of your activity
- proposed costs
- references.

Preference will be given to applicants who are permanent residents or citizens of Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. The selection panel is comprised members of the Australia and New Zealand Scholarships and Grant Committee (ANZSGC).

Acknowledgment

The grant is to be acknowledged by the recipient in all related communication as the Murray and Unity Pheils Travel Grant (supported by the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons), and is to be accompanied by the Foundation for Surgery logo on all related presentations.
